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8 Days Best to Uttarakhand

2N Mussoorie - 2N Chopta - 2N Rishikesh - 1N Jim Corbett

Day Wise Itinerary -

Day 1 - Arrival and Mussoorie

Meet our driver at Delhi airport /station and drive to Mussoorie. Check into the hotel arrival in Mussoorie. Overnight stay at Mussoorie.

Mussoorie: Established by the British in 1823, The British impact is still visible in architecture of the churches, libraries, hotels and summer palaces. During the clear weather, views of the green Doon Valley and the distant white-capped Himalayan peaks are superb. In the hot months the cooler temperatures and fresh mountain air make a welcome break from the plains below. Central Mussoorie consists of two developed areas: Gandhi Chowk (also called Library Bazaar) at the western end, and the Picture Palace at the eastern end, linked by the 2km long Mall road.

Day 2 - Mussoorie local sightseeing

Morning after breakfast, Enjoy local Mussoorie Sightseeing. Visit Kempty Falls. Later visit Library Chowk. From here you can walk on Mall Road. Visit Gun Hill by Cable Car from the Mall Road. Views from the top of the Gun Hill are mesmerizing. It is also popular for sunset views. Visit Picture palace. Night stay at the hotel.

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Day 3 - Mussoorie to Chopta

After breakfast, proceed to Chopta. Enroute visit Tehri dam. Reach Chopta in the evening and check in to the hotel.

Overnight Chopta.

Day 4 - Chopta

After breakfast, trek to worlds highest shiva temple Tungnath. Return back to the hotel by evening. Overnight Chopta

Day 5 - Chopta to Rishikesh

After Breakfast, Checkout and Drive to Rishikesh. Take a halt at Devprayag to witness the Sangam of Alaknanda and Bhagirathi rivers which gives birth to River Ganga. Attend Ganga aarti at triveni ghat. Overnight in Rishikesh

Day 6 - Rishikesh Local Sightseeing

Morning after breakfast, visit Shivpuri / Mohan Chatti for Water Sports & Rope Activities at your own cost like Rafting, Zip Line, Bungy, Flying Fox. For Bungy Jump advance booking is necessary because it is mostly sold out 15-30 days before depending on holidays. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 7 - Rishikesh to Jim Corbett

Morning after breakfast, check out from the hotel. Drive to Corbett. Check into the hotel arrival in Corbett. Evening relax yourself or enjoy sightseeing at Garjiya Devi Temple and Kosi River. Overnight stay at Corbett.

Jim Corbett National Park: Corbett National park is situated in Nainital district of Uttarakhand state. Corbett National Park is one of the oldest national parks in India. Jim Corbett National Park is the 1st wildlife reserve of India, extending over an area of more than 500 sq km in the Himalayan foothills. It is named after the legendary hunter-turned-conservationist Jim Corbett. Jim Corbett is best known for his hunting man-eating tigers and leopards in the Kumaon and lower Garhwal in the 1920s. Jim Corbett National Park comprises an area of 520 Sq kms. Jim Corbett National Park means dense forests, grasslands, rivers, more than 110 species of trees, more than 50 species of mammals, more than 580 species of birds & more than 25 species of reptiles.

Day 8 - Safari and then Delhi Airport Drop

Morning enjoy Jungle Safari. After breakfast, check out from the hotel, drive back to Delhi railway station/ Airport for a drop.
